



Guest Information

The following conditions have been developed to provide all guests, residents and invited visitors with a safe, happy and relaxing stay whilst at the Port Sorell Caravan Park.

Reception is located at 40 Darling Street, Port Sorell TAS 7307 and is staffed from 9 am to 4 pm Monday to Sunday.

The peak period is November 1 to Easter Tuesday (every year) inclusive of all Tasmanian public holidays.

The reception hours during the peak periods are -

Monday-Friday 8:30am - 5:00pm
Saturday 9:00am - 5:00pm
Sunday 10:00am - 4:00pm

The office is closed on Christmas Day & Good Friday.

Check-in is 1:00 pm.

Check-out is 11:00 am.

Late check-outs or early check-ins are at the discretion of management and must be pre-arranged.

All tariffs are payable at the time of booking except for Christmas/Summer bookings which are to be paid by November 15th (the month prior to Christmas) & Public Holiday weekend bookings which are to be paid for by the 15th (of the month prior to the public holiday weekend).

There is a strict **10km/h speed limit**. This includes electric bikes and scooters.

Access to all Amenities and the boom gate (if applicable) is via a fob. One fob per site is issued when checking in.

Site Occupancy is for two adults and the children of these adults up to the age of 18 years. All sites are designed for one caravan OR camper trailer OR family-sized tent and a small tent or swags for children AND one vehicle OR boat. This rule is at the discretion of the caretaker and all special requests must be approved before check-in.

Guests under the age of 18 years are not permitted to stay unless accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.

Children - Parents/carers are responsible for all minors in their care. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult to recreation areas, amenities, camp kitchen etc. Minors should not be roaming the park after dark.

A fenced, public playground for preschoolers is located to the north of the Port Sorell Memorial Hall with an unfenced playground alongside for Under 8's.

Quiet Time is from 10:00pm and 8:00am. Rowdy or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.

Management reserves the right to ask anyone to leave the Park.

Dogs must be disclosed at the time of booking and comply with the Park's Dog Policy Terms and Conditions supplied as a weblink on your booking confirmation email.

Generators are prohibited throughout the Park.

Out-of-date **Gas bottles** must not be used.

All **grey water** must be disposed of in the sullage point, if provided, or on the grass, not the shrubs/trees.

A key to the **Camp Kitchen** is available from reception on request. The Camp kitchen must remain locked when not in use due to the gas cooker available for use.

Washing of vehicles and cleaning of fish within the park is **PROHIBITED**. There is a car, boat and dog washing facility at 1 Burgess Drive, Shearwater.

Fencing is for windbreaks only, not to demarcate your site and must be no higher than 1.5m or longer than 5m.

2 x **laundries** and clotheslines are provided at the park. Washing powder is available to purchase from reception. All loads are \$4 each - Main amenities laundry uses 4 x \$1 coins. Boat Ramp Laundry uses a mixture of \$2 and \$1 coins. Gold coins are available at reception but we can only offer cash for coin swaps - no Eftpos.

Pet blankets are not to be washed in the washing machines. No rope clotheslines are permitted.

Fire pots may be used except in periods of a total fire ban. Firepots must be at least 30cm off the ground and have a tray to catch ash and coals. No wood is to be collected from trees within the Park. Empty your **COLD** ash into skips, not in the bush.

Smoking is not permitted in any amenities or common areas inside the caravan park grounds.

Visitors are welcome while you are present at the park and their behaviour is your responsibility. All visitors must park outside the caravan park. Visitors are to be off-site by 10:00 pm.

Large skip **garbage** bins are located at the end of North Esplanade, near reception, near the Don Brown Gazebo reserve, at the Boat Ramp amenities on East Esplanade and at the entrance to the park off Boat Ramp access Road.

Please wrap garbage before placing it in the relevant bin. Site rubbish must not be disposed of in the amenities.

Safety - Park management and the Latrobe Council accept no responsibility for loss or damage to belongings or for personal injury to you or your visitors. If any damage is seen or caused, please report to Park management ASAP. Please report vandalism, property damage, dangerous or abusive behaviour to Tasmania Police on 131 444.

Dump Points - Please dispose of your waste in the dump point in Darling Street (just outside the Park's main entrance) prior to departure. Other nearby public dump points are located at -

- behind Station Square via Cotton Street, Latrobe.
- at Girdlestone Park Football Ground in Car Park, John Street, East Devonport.
- at Horsehead Creek Riverside Park, 19A Devonport Road, Devonport.

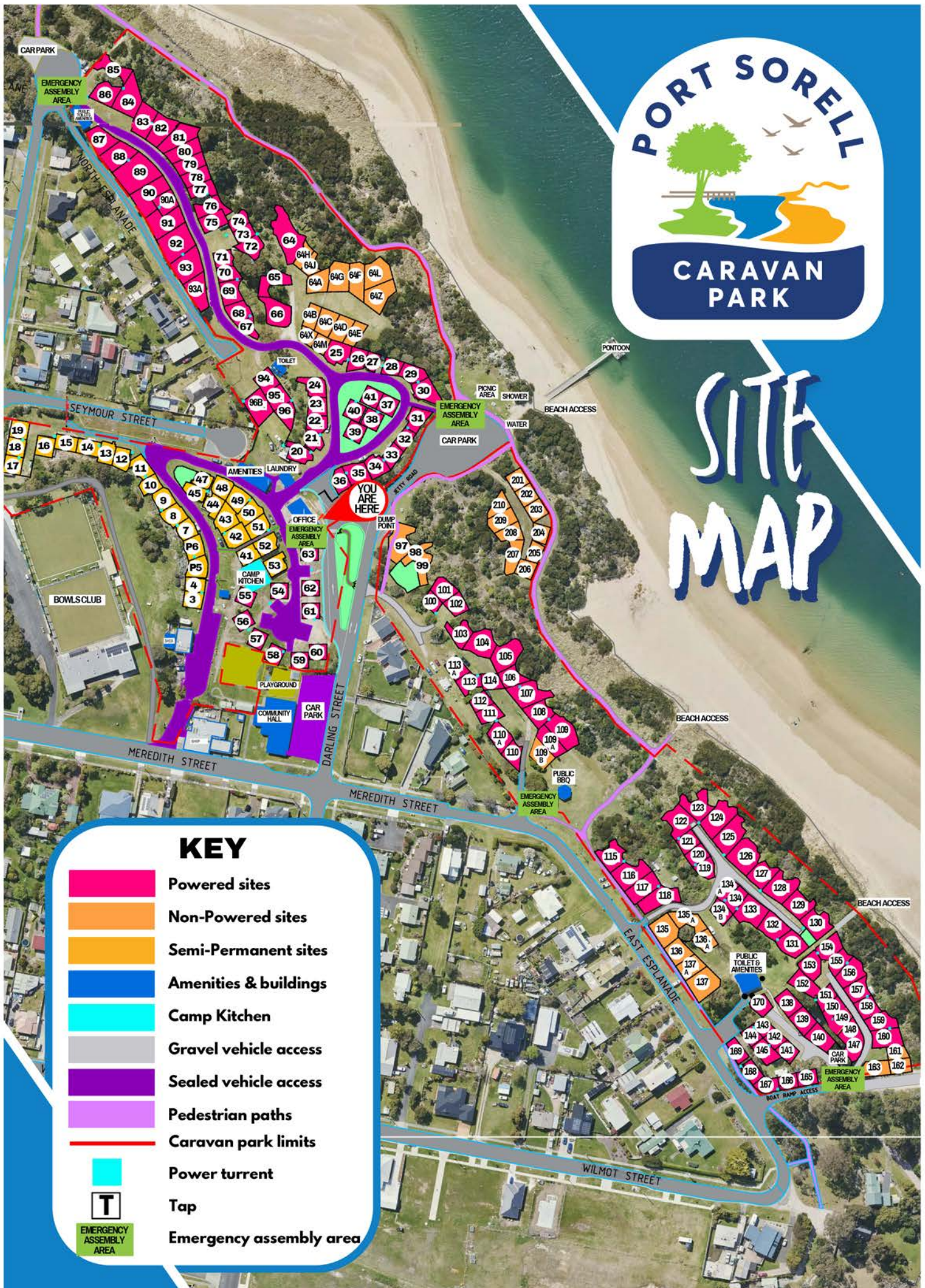
In an **emergency**, move quickly to your nearest emergency assembly areas and await further instructions from Park management.
